◆ Presentation of financial standing

- Funds from comedy night \$7319 – expenses = total profit of \$4133.08
- Of that we need to put aside \$1000 for next year comedy night.
- \$9262.88 in bank account at the moment before checks come out of the account.
- 3275.00 earmarked to start our next school year
- We can write a check to the school for the new basketball courts for the amount of \$2900 (keep in the H&S funds and we can campaign towards getting the \$8000 we need for the courts earmark funds to the campaign.)
